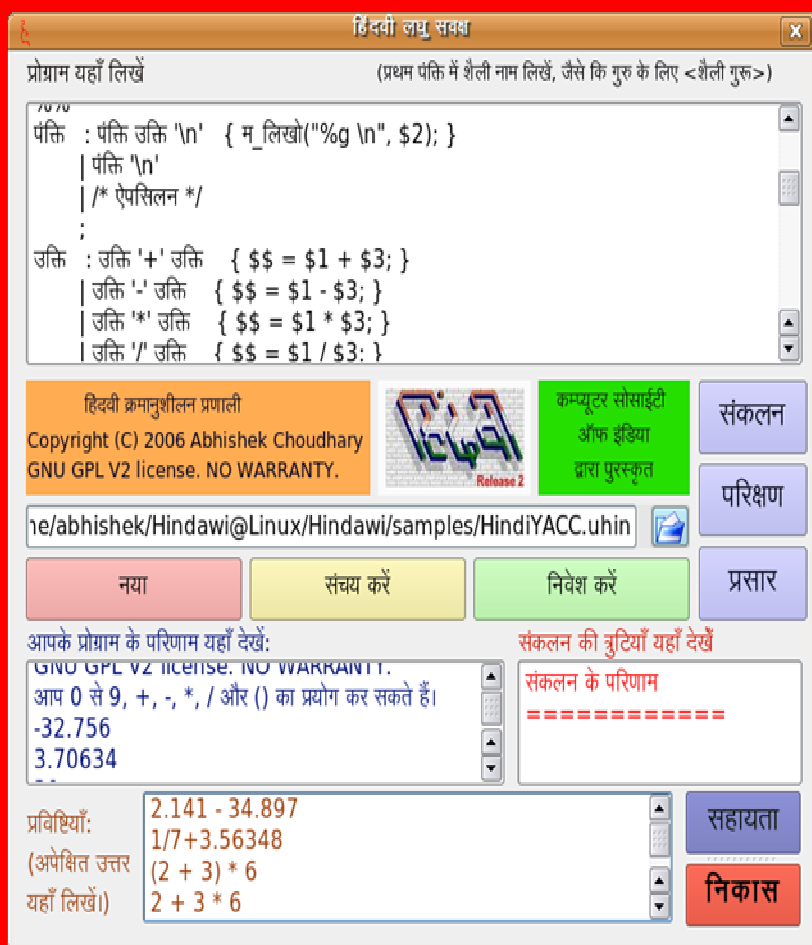
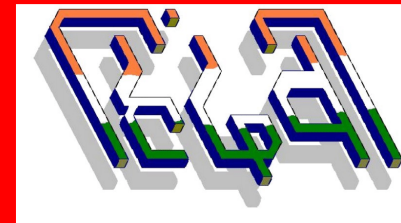


Fellowship for projects on Hindawi Programming System



Conway's game of life, lexical analysis, numerical methods, device drivers – do these require knowledge of English? At Project Hindawi we believe that one should only focus on acquiring computer science skills without any language barriers. Only 5% of India's population is skilled in English. The other 95% has been literally unaware of the Information Technology developments. There have been good efforts at localizing application software. However, localized applications alone will result in the mother-tongue literate population becoming consumers of IT products who cannot participate in producing new software, even for the captive domestic market. Project Hindawi www.hindawi.in has created software products that allow people to write programs in their own language, without a need to first learn English. **Even you can participate in these efforts with paid fellowships.**

Hindawi Programming System (HPS) is a suite of open-source Indic programming languages. It includes compilers for the Hindi equivalents of C, C++, lex, yacc, assembly, BASIC, etc. The technology is scalable to all Indian languages. These allow people without a knowledge of English to take up computer sciences and participate in the IT revolution at all levels of technology, from primary school education to robotics and super-computing in their mother tongue. HPS has been the recipient of **FOSS India Awards 2008** and **National Young IT Professional Award 2005**.

A part of the development of HPS has been supported under the **Sarai/CSDS FLOSS Fellowship**. Sarai continues to invite fellowship proposals for further development of Hindawi. Some project ideas include HPS-Eclipse integration, machine translation of comments, porting HPS to other languages and creating training videos. A comprehensive list is available online.
